**AUDIOLOGIST** *A medical ear –* Evaluates the hearing abilities of the hearing impaired and looks for the causes and contributing factors to their disability. \$23,90 / h - 44,12 / h



**BIOMEDICAL ENGINEER** *Making sure everything works!* – Ensure that their facility's medical equipment remain functional, reliable and effective. \$23,21 / h - 44,01 / h



**CLINICAL BIOCHEMIST** *Lab-based medical professional* – Determine a diagnosis and follow the evolution of a disease, as well as the effectiveness of treatments. \$38,62 / h - 50,08 / h

**MEDICAL PHYSICIST** *From theory to practice* – Medical physicists apply physics in various fields including radiation oncology, diagnostic radiology, nuclear medicine and radiation protection. \$36,68 / h - 50,79 / h

**BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN** *The equipment specialist* – Installs and configures the biomedical electronic equipment and its safety. \$20,42 / h - 28,58 / h



**MEDICAL ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY TECHNICIAN** *Handle with care* – Medical electrophysiology technicians perform medical examinations using precise electronic devices to measure and record heart and brain activity. \$22,94 / h - 31,37 / h

**NUCLEAR MEDICINE TECHNOLOGIST** *Seeing is knowledge* – Performs radiology exams to analyze the functioning of organs and body systems. \$23,12 / h - 33,61 / h

**PARAMEDIC** *Behind the siren* – Beyond transporting the sick and injured, ambulance attendants must respond swiftly, assess the patient's condition and stabilize them. \$23,63 / h - 35,32 / h
