Our Services



24/7 Phone Support

As the entry point for our services, the direct phone line is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It provides immediate support to anyone in distress, whether they are suicidal or not. The phone service is also available for concerned relatives or health professionals who want to get a referral.



Assessment, Guidance and Referrals

Over-the-phone or in-person assessments provide an overview of the person's situation and needs and determine the required services.



Crisis Follow-up in the Community

Crisis follow-up can take place directly in the community according to the person's wishes and needs. The team sets up rapid and intensive follow-up to resolve the crisis. How long the person is followed will depend on the crisis resolution goals, and the service episode may last up to a maximum of 6 to 8 weeks.



Crisis Housing

When someone must be removed from their home environment, we can arrange for short-term crisis housing.
